The Epiphany celebrates, by virtue of the arrival of the Wise Men from the East, the fact that Jesus the Messiah for the Jews came to be the Christ for all humanity also.

The **Feast of the Epiphany of our Lord** will be celebrated at Holy Trinity Church, York at 5.30 p.m. on Sunday, 4th January with a special service of readings and carols, not unlike the service before Christmas. After the service there will be a reception at The Rectory.

We recall that Jesus, as with all his followers, was called to be baptised, and so the **Baptism of Jesus** in the Jordan River by John the Baptist is celebrated.

On Friday, 23rd January, a special service to remember the first Colonial Chaplain, **the Rev'd John Burdett Wittenoom**, will take place at Holy Trinity Church, York. The service will recall not only his ministry but his contribution to the educational and cultural life of early colonial settlement. Wittenoom was granted 9,000 acres of land which he called "Gwambygine".

In celebrating momentous moments in the lives of two great Apostles: **Confession of St Peter and Conversion of St Paul** we recall how St Peter magnificently confesses Jesus to be the Messiah/the Christ, and St Paul who as Saul the Pharisee had been a cruel persecutor of those who followed in the Way of Jesus Christ, is miraculously converted on the road to Damascus.

There will be a special **Patronal Festival Service** in honour of St Paul at 5 p.m. on Sunday, 8th February at **St Paul's Church, Edward's Crossing**. After the service members of the congregation are welcome to adjoin to a local hotel for a meal.

In the Parish of Quairading members of the **Anglican, Catholic and Uniting churches** will be joining for worship in each other's churches from Sunday, 28th December, 2025 to Sunday, 1st February, 2026.
