World Labyrinth Day – In honour of World Labyrinth Day which celebrated worldwide usually on the first Saturday of May there will be celebrations at the Labyrinth at St Faith's Church on **Friday, 1st May**. School students are welcome to come by after school, while families and adults are welcome to refreshments from 5.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.

Blessing of the Plough – With the planting of crops commencing in the Valley we commence our Blessing of Plough ceremonies. While ploughs are rarely used in modern farming it is good to acknowledge our dependence upon God in all things and ask his blessing upon our 2026 planting season. On **Sunday, 10th May at 10.00 a.m. there will be the first of these at St John in the Wilderness Church, The Dale**. A "bring and share" lunch will follow in the hall. On **Saturday, 16th May at 5.30 p.m. at St Faith's Church, Quairading**, there will be the second service and finally at **St Andrew's Church, Greenhills on Sunday, 17th May at 10.30 a.m.** After that service congregants will adjourn to White Gum Farm for lunch.

Ascension Day – This year, with the exception of Holy Trinity Church, York, Ascension Day will be celebrated at the normal weekend service following Ascension Day.

Combined Parishes' Fifth Day Service – Sunday, 31st May is the Fifth Sunday of the Month so there will be a combined Churches' service to celebrate **Trinity Sunday at St Mark's Church, Brookton, commencing at 10.00 a.m.** with a "bring and share" lunch to follow.
